Caledonia Hydro Relocation Late Spring 2014

The Eglinton Crosstown is a transit project that will provide rapid and reliable service across Eglinton Avenue including an underground central section and will be up to 60% faster than bus service today.

Work is Progressing


What: Crews are relocating various utilities for the construction of the Caledonia Station headwalls. Headwalls are underground support walls located at the east and west ends of the future station location. **Initial utility relocation work and installation of headwalls began in May 2013 and will continue until late spring 2014.**

Why: These station headwalls are required to be in place prior to the arrival of tunnel boring machines at each of the station locations along the Eglinton Crosstown route. Construction of the headwalls requires the utilities to be moved safely out of the way during the installation of the headwalls. Depending on site conditions, gas, hydro, water mains, sewers, traffic and street lighting and telephone lines may be relocated to allow for the installation.

Where: The work zone is currently extended east of Gabian Way and west side of Croham Road along Eglinton Avenue West. The work zone is located to the north side of Eglinton Avenue West. Barriers are used to separate the work zone from the traffic.

When: Work continues through to late spring 2014. Crews will occupy a section of the roadway for until spring 2014 until the work at this location is complete. Some work may be rescheduled due to weather.

Traffic Details

Traffic will continue to be reduced to one lane in each direction and shifted to the north side of Eglinton from east of Gabian Way and extend to west side of Croham Road along Eglinton Avenue West.

Please take care when travelling near construction areas. Pedestrian walkways will remain open, please watch for additional signs directing pedestrians.

Work Hours

The hours of work as permitted by the by-law for this contract are between 7a.m. and 11p.m., seven days a week, when required. The contractor will not always work during the extended hours, but may do so at its discretion.

Transit Stop Relocations

Both eastbound and westbound TTC stops in the affected area will be relocated for the safety of the transit riders. Watch for posted signs indicating the locations.
